## **UPEACE ONLINE PROGRAMME STRUCTURE 2020-21**

UPEACE Online Programme offers the following options within the programme in 2020-21:

### **A. Online MA in Sustainable Peace in the Contemporary World**

**Tuition fee:** USD 15,000

Students can obtain the Online MA in Sustainable Peace in the Contemporary World upon successful completion of 42 credits, including 36 credits for course work and 6 credits for a final independent research project (IRP).

In order to graduate from the programme, students must undertake the courses marked as 'Mandatory' (15 credits) in the list below. In addition, students must take optional courses (21 credits) from the list, before completing their final graduation project (IRP).

### **B. Online Diploma in Peace Studies**

**Tuition Fee:** USD 5,000

Students can also obtain an Online Diploma in Peace Studies upon successfully completing courses worth 12 credits offered within the Online MA programme, and additionally, writing a final academic exam. Students opting for the Online Diploma can choose any of the courses offered by the Programme.

**Tuition Fee:**
